

ORDINANCE NO. 6317

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING A SOLE SOURCE AGREEMENT WITH HOPE WORKS JOB EXPERIENCE PROGRAM FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

**WHEREAS**, homelessness is a significant public issue for many Hot Springs citizens; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hot Springs ("City") supports and encourages programs that address the critical health and safety needs of homeless individuals; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City and the Hope Works Job Experience Program ("HWJE") wish to combine their resources to develop a pilot project to help ensure that Hot Springs persons experiencing homelessness have a work opportunity and access to support services; and that

**WHEREAS**, the Hope Works Job Experience Program provides homeless persons with paid work opportunities by picking up debris in designated areas within the City of Hot Springs ("Program") is further detailed and attached hereto as the, "Memorandum Of Understanding For The Persons Experiencing Homelessness Pilot Project Between The City Of Hot Springs And Hope Works Job Experience Program".

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Directors of the City of Hot Springs, Arkansas, as follows:

**SECTION ONE:** The funds for this pilot program will come from the Hot Springs Solid Waste account, in an amount of up to Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$80,000.00).

**SECTION TWO:** The term of the attached Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") between the City and Hope Works Job Experience Program shall expire on December 31, 2020; thereafter, said MOU may be renewed by the governing body for a successive one (1) year term upon mutual consent of the parties.

**SECTION THREE:** That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the attached MOU with Hope Works Job Experience Program and further authorized to administer and act on behalf of the City with regard to this agreement.
