

ORDINANCE NO. 6411

AN ORDINANCE WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING AND ACCEPTING A PROPSAL FROM SPRINTURF, LLC FOR TURF REPLACEMENT AT KIMERY PARK.

WHEREAS, Kimery Park currently has four turf infields in need of replacement; and

WHEREAS, Sprinturf, LLC was recently selected for and completed the installation of the turf fields at Majestic Park after being selected by Hill & Cox as the lowest responsive bidder among the 5 bidders; and

WHEREAS, Sprinturf, LLC has submitted a proposal to the City of Hot Springs in which the company would re-turf all 4 Kimery Park fields for half the price of the current estimate and complete the work by the opening of the 2022 softball season so long as Sprinturf can begin the project in February 2022, and

WHEREAS, A.C.A. §14-47-138 (b) provides that " The board, by ordinance, may waive the requirement of competitive bidding in exceptional situations where this procedure is not feasible..."; and


WHEREAS, pursuant to A.C.A. §14-47-138 (b), the recent award by Hill & Cox as the lowest responsive bidder for a similar project, the time frame for completion being prior to the start of the 2022 softball season and the significant discounted price make competitive procurement for replacement of the Kimery Park fields not practical or feasible and it is in the best interest of the City to waive said requirement and approve the proposal submitted by Sprinturf, LLC.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the City of Hot Springs, Arkansas:


Section 1: That competitive bidding for the turf replacement on 4 softball fields at Kimery Park is not practical or feasible and, thus, is hereby waived pursuant to A.C.A. §14-47-138 (b). The waiver is based on the following; Sprinturf, LLC was recently selected as the lowest responsive bidder by Hill & Cox and has successfully completed the installation of fields at Majestic Park, has proposed to replace the four fields at Kimery Park for half the price of the current quote and can complete the resurfacing prior to the start of the 2022 softball season.

Section 2: That the proposal from Sprinturf, LLC for the replacement of four (4) turf softball fields at Kimery Park in the amount of \$389,230.00 is hereby accepted and approved; provided further, that the City Manager is authorized to engage Sprinturf, LLC for the project described in the approved proposal and, with the advice and consent of the City Attorney, to execute a subsequent contract associated with this acceptance of the scope of work and pricing set forth in said proposal, as well as to act on behalf of the City in the administration thereof.
