ORDINANCE NO. 6440

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE 2022 HOT SPRINGS ELECTRICAL CODE; REPEALING CERTAIN ORDINANCES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Hot Springs Code Title 15 establishes the rules and regulations regarding minimum building and construction standards for the public health, safety and welfare; and

WHEREAS, city staff requests that the Board of Directors adopt an updated City of Hot Springs Electrical Code that is consistent with most recent National Electrical Code (NEC), and

WHEREAS, copies of the National Electrical Code, 2020 edition, are on file in the office of the City Clerk for inspection and viewing by the public; and notice thereof has been made by publication in the Sentinel Record newspaper.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Directors of the City of Hot Springs, Arkansas, as follows:

SECTION 1. Adoption. That the Attached 2022 Hot Springs Electrical Code is hereby adopted.

SECTION 2. Repealer. All ordinances, resolutions, or parts of the same, that are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency; including but not limited to Ordinance No. 6241.

SECTION 3. Codification. This ordinance shall be codified in the Hot Springs Code of Ordinances and the sections thereof may be re-lettered or renumbered to accomplish such intention.
